

Keuring and Equine Care Code of Conduct

Should the soundness, health or behaviour of a participating horse be questioned, the Organisers, after consultation with the person responsible for the horse and an official veterinarian if necessary, shall make the decision as to whether the horse may continue to participate.

The Organisers decision shall be final.

1. The welfare of the horse is paramount and shall be considered above the demands of breeders, trainers, riders, drivers, owners, organisers, sponsors and officials.
2. The highest standards of nutrition, health, sanitation and safety of the horse shall be encouraged and maintained at all times during the 2025 keuring.
3. Riding, driving, handling and training methods shall not include any technique which might be considered abusive to the horse.
4. Adequate provision must be made for maintaining a healthy and safe environment for the transport and stabling of horses to and from the 2025 keuring.
5. If a horse poses a threat to any attendees, organisers or other participants of the event, the keuring organiser will have the right to remove the horse from the area.
